## Stockholm School of Economics in Riga Student Association Minutes April 14<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup>

Due to Easter holidays, great workload of studies, and SA exchange trip, April turned out to be quite a short month for SA activities. Nevertheless, all members of the Board met soon after the end of holidays to discuss the upcoming issues. Hence, the second official Board meeting took place on the 16<sup>th</sup> of April. Three guests participated in this meeting: the chief editor of Insider Laurynas Antanavičius, and Days of Opportunities Organizers Janis Zeps and Marten Orgna. Promotion Coordinator Mindaugas Čekauskas was also present. During the meeting the Board the following points were discussed:

- 1) The Insider -
  - The Insider will be officially defined as a temporary committee of the Student Association.
  - SA members will look more responsibly at the deadlines for the Insider.
  - The President, the Vice, Business Committee and Information Committee will be responsible for checking the PDF file of the Insider issue, and will have to guarantee that it will not be spread.
  - Insider and SA representatives will attend each others' board meetings to improve communication.
- 2) Days of Opportunities -
  - DoO will work further for the benefit of SSE Riga community and will take any necessary means to maximize the revenue from the event. The profit of DoO will continue to be distributed to SA budget as to be used for the needs of SSE Riga students.
  - DoO after party should be organized as a reward for DoO team. Approximately 20 people will be invited to the party, and around 20 LVL will be spent on each of them.
- 3) Cooperation with the Embassy of Lithuania -
  - A group of SSE Riga students will help Lithuanian Embassy to represent the country during the event on the 1<sup>st</sup> of May. Mindaugas Čekauskas, together with the Vice, will organize the details of the event.

**The SA exchange trip to Stockholm** took place April 24-28. During the trip SA participated in the events dedicated to the 100 years anniversary of the Student Association of Stockholm School of Economics, socialized with Swedish SA members during various activities organized by the hosts, visited Stockholm School of Economics and the building of the Student Association, and participated in the board meeting – presentation of the Student Association in Stockholm. The outcomes of the trip will be presented in the next Issue of the Insider.
