



## SA Minutes

**15th of October, 2008**

The following is a summary of the key issues that were discussed during the meeting of the Student Association Board that took place on October 15, 2008. The main issues to consider were the upcoming elections of a new Student Association Board, traditional meeting with the Student Association of the Stockholm School of Economics in Stockholm and the launching of the new SA's webpage.

**The elections of the new Student Association Board.** The following is the schedule for the elections procedure that was set during the meeting:

**October 20, 15:00** – SA Board's presentation for Year 1 students

**October 27** – students and the Administration must be informed about the General Meeting during which Elections Committee will be elected, IT Committee idea will be presented and any other suggested issues will be discussed.

**November 3** – General Meeting

**November 6-16** – time for application. Students must send their motivation letters and pictures for the Insider

**November 23-December 3** – promotional week

**December 1-3** – presentations of candidates

**December 4-5** – 1st round of voting

**December 10** – debates of the presidential couples

**December 10-11** – 2nd round of voting

**December 12** – deadline for the Elections Committee to deliver final results to the Insider

**December 19** – announcement of the final results

**Traditional trip to Stockholm.** The Student Association of the Stockholm School of Economics in Stockholm is going to visit SSE Riga on November 7-9. The guests will have a meeting with SSE Riga SA, the Administration, participate in a Homecoming party. A trip around Riga will be organized as well. A separate meeting of the Student Association will be held in order to plan the visit in detail.

The Student Association of SSE Riga will visit Stockholm on November 13-18. The travelling and accommodation costs will be covered by the Swedish SA.

**SA's webpage.** The new webpage of the Student Association is ready to be launched; however, the design should still be improved. Marten Orgna was made responsible for finalizing it till the General Meeting (November 3).

**Baptizing Party.** The Baptizing party was very successful and raised more than 300 LVL revenues. A separate meeting of the SA will be organized in order to carefully plan the costs of a Homecoming party on November 7 and make it of the same quality.

**Cooperation with Alumni.** On October 9 a meeting with the representatives of SSE Riga Alumni Association was held during which various cooperation possibilities were discussed. It was agreed that the SA will provide information



about the events happening at school for Alumni Newsletter every two weeks. The alumni will also cooperate with the Insider. Moreover, the alumni expressed their willingness to cooperate during practical activities of various courses such as Organization and Management, Marketing Shadow Day, etc. They also promised to help sponsoring some events.
